About the Scavenger Hunt

It is all about fun, cleverness, route planning, begging strangers for help and hanging out with others who think walking is fun! This free and family friendly, get-to-know-Wilmington-better event is just an excuse to have a good time and enjoy a spring walk...with a little spirited competition thrown in! The optimized route is about three miles, so comfortable shoes are a must!!!

Be careful walking, keep your eyes open and obey all pedestrian safety rules (the ones your mother taught you and the ones you figured out on your own).

About the Teams

- Teams are 3-6 people (recommended) and they must stay together. We highly recommend that you have at least one "townie" on your team!
- Each team must have a cell phone and digital camera, paper and pencil. A few other items will be supplied that morning.
- Everything must be done by foot or stroller or wheelchair. (Unusual means requires pre-approval). That is right, no cars or bicycles!
- Registration is limited to 15 teams, so don't wait to register!

Event Details

- Teams will gather at the Municipal Building Community Room at 9:00 a.m.
- The rules and all team materials will be handed out.
- Then teams will have time and space to "plan" their route and take off whenever they are ready.
- Based on the provided list of "sites" each team will acquire "proof" as noted on the scavenger hunt list. You must bring your proof back with you!
- All teams must return to the Community Room by 11:00 a.m.

Who Wins?

- That is up to the revered judges. Judges will review each team's evidence and points will be awarded based on their assessment. All decisions of the judges are final (unless you disagree with good reason and you are very convincing!)
- Judges may subjectively deduct points for poor quality proof (or any other reason).
- Judges may subjectively add points for outstanding proof or the composition of the team (or any other factor).

Teams can get extra points for evidence of a pedestrian safety condition. Proof must be presented to the judges
